\boxtimes	The review area is comprised entirely of dry land (i.e., there are no waters or water features, including
	wetlands, of any kind in the entire review area). Rationale: The project will occur in a highly disturbed,
	developed parcel which is within a larger parcel owned by the applicant. The jurisdictional
	determination was requested for the 2.00 acre section of the larger 5.92 acre property; and so the final
	determination will be limited only to the 2.00 acre section. A desktop survey indicates potential hydric
	soils along the eastern section of the review area. Approximately one-third of the review area (eastern
	end) appears to contain 85% Atmore fine sandy loams at a summit to toeslope of the upland
	topography. However, this area also contains two existing buildings with associated driveways and fill.
	Bilbo Creek flows to the east of the subject property, outside of the review area. Wetlands adjacent to
	Bilbo Creek appear to be entirely outside of the review area. Aerial and street view imagery indicate no
	hydrology exists, nor do hydrophytic, obligate, or facultative wetland plant species appear to be present
	within the review area. Dominant vegetation appears to be domestic lawn grass species with scattered
	saplings.
