$\boxtimes$	The review area is comprised entirely of dry land (i.e., there are no waters or water features, including wetlands, of any kind in the entire review area). Rationale: A desktop review was conducted for the
	subject project's approximately 18-acre undeveloped property, which revealed the project would occur
	within a site comprised of uplands with no jurisdictional water bodies within the parcel. The subject review area is surrounded by undeveloped forested land and is bordered on the west end by 6th
	Avenue. Nearby land use appears to be 50% silviculture/farmland with mixed low-density single-family
	residential and nearby industrial land use. On-site soils are shown to be indicative of ridges or summit
	terraces including Cowarts-Dothan complex with Dothan and Malbis sandy loams and Orangeburg
	sandy loam complex. An on-site drainage feature is shown along the central western border, however,
	review of Google Earth street view imagery as well as wetland delineation data and site photos
	provided by the agent indicates no hydrology nor hydrophytic plant species are present within this
	western area of the parcel. Dominant vegetation comprises FAC and UPL species including Pinus
	taeda, Liriodendron tulipifera, Ligustrum sinense, and Vaccinium arboreum.
