#### II. FINDINGS

The review area is comprised entirely of dry land (i.e., there are no waters or water features, including
wetlands, of any kind in the entire review area). Rationale: A desktop review was conducted for the
boundaries within Meadowwood Parcels 1 and 3 which comprise of review area boundaries of 8.60-
acres and 15.95-acres, respectively, of undeveloped cleared agricultural property. The final
determination will be limited only to the 8.60-acre and 15.95-acre sections within the larger property.
The desktop review indicates the review area is comprised of uplands with no jurisdictional waters
including wetlands within. Land use is agricultural and is bordered on the west by mixed hardwod
forested and mixed hardwood forested wetlands adjacent to Cripple Creek tributary, and on the north
and east by Veterans Memorial Parkway and Highway 9. On-site soils are shown to be well drained
non-hydric profiles indicative of ridges or summit terraces including Cowarts-Dothan complex. Wetland
delineation data and site photos provided by the agent indicate no hydrology nor hydrophytic plant
species are present within the review areas. Dominant vegetation within the review boundaries
comprises FAC and UPL species including Liriodendron tulipifera, Ligustrum sinense, Cyperus
rotundus, and Smilax rotundifolia.
