\boxtimes	The review area is comprised entirely of dry land (i.e., there are no waters or water features, including
	wetlands, of any kind in the entire review area). Rationale: The project review area is limited to the
	footprint of an approximately 21,000-linear-foot trail located within subject property. The project will
	occur in a highly disturbed area which is located within a larger parcel owned by the applicant. The
	jurisdictional determination was requested for the region along previously disturbed and filled areas of a
	pre-existing state park recreational campground and park with associated cleared trails and paved
	roads (as shown on the attached maps and aerial photos). A desktop survey of the linear trail project
	area found on-site soils to be primarily non-hydric Annmain-Wahee and Blanton-Bonneau complex; and
	the USFWS National Wetland Inventory does not show hydrology or special aquatic resource sites
	within the subject review area. Additionally, site photographs and documentation provided by the
	applicant further support the review area will occur within previously disturbed uplands and is comprised
	entirely of dry land with any potential fill impacts to wetlands or water features avoided.
