II. FINDINGS

The review area is comprised entirely of dry land (i.e., there are no waters or water features, including wetlands, of any kind in the entire review area). Rationale: The subject review area is located entirely
within an existing previously disturbed and filled road right-of-way (ROW) along Pea Ridge Road.
Three culverted unnamed tributary/stream crossings exist within the review area, under which the proposed new water main line will be installed via horizontal directional drill (HDD) bore methods with entry and exit bore pits placed entirely within upland areas of the existing ROW, as shown in attached project maps. An additional area of drainage wetland crossing is present near the central area of the project site, which will also be entirely avoided by the same HDD bore methods. Dominant soils within the review area include non-hydric Poarch fine sandy loams, non-hydric Esto and Dothan profiles, and also non-hydric Orangeburg fine sandy loams with Lucy loamy sands, and hydric Bibb soils within the stream crossing areas which will be completely avoided through HDD boring within adjacent dry land
uplands.
